

Fact Sheet 2 Young Enterprise Primary Programme

Through the Young Enterprise Programme, Primary School pupils can learn about money, taxes and understand how and why individuals, families, communities and nations work together.

The model is that a business advisor works with a class on a variety of hands on activities to enable children to better understand the 'World of Work' through six module themes. Each module is for a different age group.

Six Primary Programmes

- Ourselves (4/5 year olds)
- Our Families (6/7 year olds)
- Our Community (7/8 year olds)
- Our City (8/9 year olds)
- Our Nation (9/10 year olds)
- Our World (10/11 year olds)

Volunteer Commitment

Volunteers commit to period of time. This is normally:

- To attend a 2 hour training session
- Read up and familiarise themselves on the Young Enterprise programme

Delivery of the programme (This can be 5 one hour sessions or one day if working with 10 -11 year olds There is flexibility to fit the needs of the school and the volunteer).

All sessions take place at the school with the teacher present. All volunteers are police checked. Volunteer attends a 2 hour training session. Volunteer follows format as prescribed by Young Enterprise in their handbook. All resources will be made available to you at the training session which will take place at the school or volunteers place of business.
